

MARSHFIELD PUBLIC SCHOOLS DRAFT BUDGET OCTOBER, 2021

OVERVIEW

The American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act of 2021,
Public Law 117-2, was enacted on March 11,
2021. The ARP Act provides additional funding for
school districts to respond to the COVID-19
Pandemic. The Education portion of ARP is known
as the Elementary and Secondary School
Emergency Relief Funds (ESSER III or ARP ESSER)

ALLOCATIONS

Similar to the earlier CARES and CRRSA Acts, states receive ESSER III funds based on their share of total Title I funding. Then, states allocate and distribute 90 percent of funds to districts based on each district's share of Title I in FY21.

Marshfield Public Schools = \$2,782,156

Funds are available through 9/30/2024.

ESSER III — USE OF FUNDS PLAN

- How the funds will be used to implement prevention and mitigation strategies aligned with CDC guidance
- How the district will use its 20% set-aside to address the academic impact of lost instructional time through evidence-based interventions, such as summer learning or summer enrichment, extended day, comprehensive afterschool programs, or extended school year programs
- How the district will spend its remaining ARP ESSER funds
- How the district will ensure that interventions employed will respond to the academic, social, emotional, and mental health needs of all students and particularly those disproportionately impacted, including students from low-income families, students of color, English learners, children w/ disabilities, students experiencing homelessness, children and youth in foster care, and migratory students
- District must make its ESSER III Use of Funds Plan publicly available on its website within 30 days of receiving its ESSER III grant application approval email.
