## DISPOSAL OF EQUIPMENT

The Marshfield Public Schools authorizes the disposal of obsolete equipment valued at less than \$5,000.00 in accordance with Uniform Procurement Act of the General Laws of Massachusetts.

Obsolete equipment is defined as:

- 1. Beyond repair or too costly to repair.
- 2. Replaced by new equipment because the old equipment no longer serves our educational needs.

Procedure to be followed for discarding obsolete equipment:

- 1. All equipment must be declared obsolete by the Building Principal
- 2. A list of the equipment, with a description of the condition, or reason for declaring it obsolete, will be forwarded to the Director of Business and Finance
- 3. Upon approval by the School Committee said equipment will be transferred to the control of the Board of Selectmen.
