

SBDM minutes May 17, 2017

Meeting was called to order- Present: Islas, Wade, Robertson, James, Fowler and Schlosser

No visitor's comments

Approved changes to the agenda: 1st Islas, 2nd Fowler- all voted in favor

Changes to the agenda was Senior Scholar discussion

Financial report 59.8% of the budget has been spent at this point.

CCR report for class of 2017 180 of 197 were CCR. 8 students will be required to do the service learning project.

SIG grant update- FSHS has applied for the maximum amount of 2 million dollars that can be awarded to a Priority school.

TELL survey results were discussed. Each council member were given a copy of the TELL results for FSHS.

Consultation on hiring for the positions of special education, PE, math and social studies were discussed.

Senior scholar discussion revolved around the issue of taking an AP course in the required 4 core areas of math, English, science and social studies. 6 AP courses are required with one from each other 4 core areas. In the class of 2018, there are no students taking a science AP course. Therefore there will not be any Senior scholars for the 2017-2018 school year. It was discussed to amend the policy to 6 AP courses and require only one class from either math or science. Discussion was tabled to June meeting.
