

SBDM minutes April 19, 2017

Meeting was called to order, members present- Robertson, Islas, James, Fowler, Wade

No visitors comments

Agenda was approved with one additional item: Add Language and Culture club- 1st James, 2nd Robertson all voted in favor.

Reviewed and accepted minutes from March meeting: 1st Robertson, 2nd James all voted in favor

Financial report was given and 58% of the budget has been spent at this point.

CCR report was given 166 of 198 are CCR- there are 17 sped students and transfers.

ACT composite preliminary score was 20.58

Cafeteria update was given with handouts/visuals of the new layout and design for the work.

Personnel report: 2 custodians have been hired, math , social studies and special education had all been posted.

2nd chance breakfast: after discussing with teacher leadership and within the departments. Mr. Schlosser is going to ask Sarah Richardson the food service if it would be possible to serve at 9:55am between 2nd period and Academic time.

Dual credit US History- FSHS is going to offer dual credit history for the first time next fall.

Senior scholar status: under current policy student must take on AP course in each core area, however only 2 students signed up for AP biology. Discussion was to talk about Senior scholar status if no students take a science course. SBDM will begin to look at the policy with possible changes to the requirement of a number of AP courses only.

School Improvement Grant: FSHS is applying for a SIG grant.

Action items:

Budget was approved as presented: 1st James, 2nd Wade all voted in favor

SBDM allocation/staffing: Created a physical education job with the extra position at FSHS. 1st Robertson, 2nd James all voted in favor.

West Campus: Credit recovery requirements: Students must have 23 credits to stay at FSHS. Any student below 23 credits will start the year at West Campus. Once they have completed their on line credit recovery class they could transfer back to FSHS main campus. 1st James, 2nd Wade all voted in favor.

Program Review assurances were signed and approved by the council. 1st James, 2nd Fowler all voted in favor.

Language and culture club proposal was presented by Ms. Sledge to establish a foreign language club. 1st James, 2nd Fowler all voted in favor.
