Meeting was called to order- present: Krysta James, Daniel King, DeAna Islas, Misty Wade, and Tim Schlosser

Agenda approved with no changes- 1<sup>st</sup> Islas, 2<sup>nd</sup> James all voted in favor

Financial report was given 59.63% of the budget has been spent.

CCR Report 157/207

Testing update on KOSSA and ACT was reported. Both test were administered and went well. Are hoping to receive scores in mid April.

Budget report: district has given preliminary budget of 100.00 per student which is going to result in about a 30,000.00 cut for FSHS.

Staffing report for FSHS is that 3 positions would be cut from the SBDM allocations with the hope of 2 after the legislative session.

Action items:

Need assessment was approved 1<sup>st</sup> James, 2<sup>nd</sup> King all voted in favor. FSHS has requested 1 full time certified position for FSHS.

Bell schedule for 2018-2019 was approved. 1<sup>st</sup> James, 2<sup>nd</sup> Wade all voted in favor. FSHS will continue to implement the same bell schedule from the previous year. 6 period day 55 minute classes with a 30 minute Academic Time period from 10:00-10:30am Monday thru Thursday. Friday schedule will start at 8:30am with no Academic Time period.

School security officers: Mr. Schlosser requested that the SBDM approve 2 officers to be present from 7:15-8:15am each morning throughout the rest of this school year. SBDM will provide the funding for this extra service at a cost of around 4,500.00.
