

SBDM Minutes  
January 20, 2015

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Craig Delk. Members present were: Michelle Cummings, Craig Delk, Jessica Link, Whitney Maxwell, Tabitha Robertson, and Heather Shaner.

A motion to approval the agenda was made by Mrs. Robertson and seconded by Mrs. Link.

Mr. Delk read the minutes from December's meeting and Mrs. Robertson made a motion to approve; Ms. Shaner seconded the motion.

Mr. Delk discussed the SWIS report data and introduced the new FSMS Behavior Matrix. Peaks were noted in the December SWIS data, but were expected because of the typical increase in behaviors before a break. A few questions were addressed concerning the Behavior Matrix: 1. Would the matrix work only horizontally, or could varying offenses "add up" to equal a consequence? At this time, the matrix will only work horizontally. 2.
