7.A. SBDM Preliminary Budget

Discussion:

Next meeting, the structure for the next school year will be discussed. We will be hit hardest in the Instructional Supplies and Materials budget which is more than \$15,000.00 less than proposed for next school year. We are projected to also lose \$21,000.00 in software money. We are not losing any positions this year. Each grade will get one field trip next year unless funded by other resources. Mrs. Pais will discuss prioritizing the instructional programs we use during the virtual faculty meeting to decide how to best spend the funds for the next school year. Mrs. Baxter suggested letting each subject area choose one instructional program to purchase next year. Go Math workbooks are purchased through next year. STAR is purchased through district funds.

7.B. Positions for the 2018-2019 School Year

Discussion:

We have 22 certified positions available. We need at least 9 homeroom teachers in each grade. Two paras equal a certified position. We will be possibly going to 5 special areas next year. We will probably start with 26 in 4th grade homerooms and 27 in 5th grade homerooms. We possibly could use the extra position as an interventionist and Pais suggested the need for a reading interventionist. Pais will be interviewing for the current opening by the end of April.
