7. New Business7.A. K-Prep Scores for 2016-2017

Discussion:

Celebrations Writing and Social Studies went up. Language Mechanics we had more P/D than the state average. The year before we had 90 minutes for reading/math instruction and saw scores increase. Last year we went down to 70 minutes for reading/math instruction (100 minutes less each week) and saw scores decrease. GAP (free and reduced lunch, African-American, SPED, ESL) scores dropped from 59.7 to 32.9. Shelina Smith explained how GAP and Growth scores are calculated. Tests taken this Spring will be used as baseline data for the new system. Mrs. Pais explained the goals for each area of improvement. Mrs. Pais has met with all of the teachers to discussion a plan of action. Our theme will be "No More Novice".

7.B. Time changes in Instruction to be discussed.

Mrs. Pais discussed time changes which would extend 4th grade reading and math instructional times from 70 minutes back to 90 minutes.
