Is my child eligible to attend Simpson County Preschool?

If your child is 4 years old by August 1st of the school year, your child may be eligible through income eligibility or by being identified with a developmental delay.

If your child is 3 years old then your child would have to be identified with a <u>developmental delay</u> to be eligible for preschool services.

Income Eligibility – This is determined by completing the Household and Income Form.

Developmental Delay – This is usually determined by a process including a free developmental screening, interventions, and evaluations. A developmental delay can be a delay in any of the following areas: Communication Skills, Cognitive Skills, Social Skills, Independent Skills, Motor Abilities, or Cognitive Skills.

Required Paperwork, upon enrollment, for Preschool

- □ Completed enrollment packet
- □ A physical, completed by a physician, on the *Kentucky Physical Exam for School Entry Form.*
- □ Immunization record A copy of the **current** shot record on the Kentucky form
- □ A copy of their Birth Certificate
- □ Social Security Card (optional)

Other required paperwork includes:

- □ A Vision Exam on the Kentucky Vision Exam for School Entry form completed by an eye doctor Due on or before January 1st.
- □ A Dental Exam on the Kentucky Dental Screening Form for School Entry completed by a dentist Due on or before January 1st.
- □ Free Developmental Screening (Conducted by school staff)

Takes turns in games

Shows concern for a crying friend

Separates easily from mom and dad

Dresses and undresses self

Follows instructions with 2 or 3 steps

Says first name, age, and sex

Talks well enough for strangers to understand most of the time

Carries on a conversation using 2 to 3 sentences

Can work toys with buttons, levers, and moving parts

Plays make-believe with dolls, animals, and people

Does puzzles with 3 or 4 pieces

Understands what "two" means

Copies a circle with pencil or crayon

Builds towers of more than 6 blocks
