FOURTH GRADE

**No pencils Boxes/ pouches are needed.

- 1 student backpack (not too large)
 - 1 pair of small in ear headphones
 - 3 sharpened or lead filled pencils
 - 1 pencil sharpener with holder for shavings
 - 2 glue sticks
 - 1 small pair of student scissors
 - 1 box of colored pencils
 - 1 box of crayons (24 count)
 - 1 small pack of square sticky notes
 - 1 flat clipboard (no storage/folders)
 - 1 large eraser
 - 1 ruler (inches and centimeters)
 - 5 book covers (not small)
 - 4 wide ruled composition books
 - 1 packages of wide ruled paper
 - 1 package of 7-tab dividers
 - 1 3-ring binder (2 inch)
 - 1 pack of lined 3X5" index cards
 - 1 pack multi-colored highlighters
 - 2 red pens
 - 1 pack of thin whiteboard markers- Black

FIFTH GRADE

- Small headphones for computer
 - 1 3-subject college-ruled spiral bound notebook w/ pocket dividers
 - 1 3-ring notebook (*at least 2 inches*)
 - 1 3-ring notebook (*1 inch*)
 - 1 set of 8 dividers with tabs and pockets for 3-ring binder
 - 1 composition book
 - 1 dozen mechanical pencils with eraser and refillable led
 - 1 pack of erasable pens (Black)
 - 1 dozen red pens
 - 1 black fine tip Sharpie
 - 1 black regular tip Sharpie
 - 1 pack of dry erase markers and eraser
 - 1 pack of Highlighters
 - 1 box of colored pencils
 - 1 box colored markers (not permanent sharpie markers)
 - 1 pair of scissors
 - 1 school box (8"x5"x2.5" - *must fit in desk*)
 - 3 packages of loose-leaf notebook paper (*not spiral bound*)

- 16.9 oz Water Bottle
 - Non-Perishable snacks (i.e. Fruit/granola bars, dried fruit, pretzels)

 - Emergency disposable rain poncho
 - Family Photograph
 - Comfort letter to remind your child to stay calm
 - Comfort Item (SMALL stuffed animal or toy to bring comfort in the event of crisis)
 - 1 small tissue pack
 - 1 small wet wipes pack
 - 1 pair of socks
- K-2nd Grade* students need one pair of underwear and one pair of shorts
- 4th-8th Grade* students need small toiletries (i.e. deodorant, feminine hygiene products)
