- ◆ Program Management which includes participation in the selection of assessment materials and equipment; develop and coordinate a continuing evaluation of the assessment program and make changes based on findings, compile, maintain, and file reports, records, and other documents required, and comply with policies established by federal and state law, State Board of Education rule, and local board policy.
