2023 CLASS CATEGORIES

Actors and Actresses: Become someone different each class through theater games. Act out parts from fun shows and commercials as well as scenes from your imagination. Through acting, directing, and costume design, you will build self-confidence, poise and public speaking skills.

Adventure Quest: Test your physical and mental abilities! Learn teamwork, communication, responsibility, leadership and respect by completing your daily challenge. Activities and games will accelerate learning and self-confidence.

American Girl Party: It's party time!! Bring your American Girl or any favorite doll for activities and crafts. Get ready for weeks of fun and adventure alongside your favorite doll.

Artist's Studio: Perfect for the child that loves art and wants to learn new skills. This class develops your child's skills with unique and fun projects. Enjoy drawing, painting, creating with clay and making collages.

Cape Ever After: Come to our enchanted classroom as you become a Disney princess for a day. Unleash your imagination with princess-themed games, crafts and activities. You are cordially invited to the royal ball on the last day for a dress-up tea party.

Cape Fit: This course uses a combination of skill development, workouts and games to build strength and conditioning in children. Students will be performing activities which include gymnastics, weight lifting, agility movements and jump training.

Cape Idol: Who wants to be the next idol of CAPE? Explore musical talents and share the experience of this hit television show with fun and exciting song selections, warm-ups and even headshots! Who knows? Maybe you will be ready for the real thing someday!

Cheerleading: Let's Go!... Let's Go! Learn exciting cheers, tumbles & jumps for your favorite team.

Chess: This class will teach the fundamentals of the game and work on improving concentration and strategic thinking. Skills included in this class are decision-making and evaluating alternatives. You will also learn multiple ways to win through guided instruction.

Coding: Do you like apps? Love video games? Are you the creator of the next big thing? Learn the basics of programming and what it takes to become a computer developer in this exciting tech-savvy group.

Crafts 4 Little Hands: Future artists will have the opportunity to paint, bead, glue, mold and explore! Projects are designed to develop fine motor skills while having FUN!

Crazy Clay: Pinch, pull and shape clay to design original works of art including masks, animal sculptures, coiled pots and more!

Cupcake Wars: This hands-on decorating class will allow you to express yourself in the most delightful and delicious way. Enjoy fun instruction as you learn the art of cupcake decorating and creative design. **Please alert the CAPE office if your child has any food allergies.**

Dance: This course includes strength and stretch exercises, progressive combinations across the floor, beginner hip-hop moves and even choreographed routines. Dance away to radio's current hits! Lightweight sneakers or ballet shoes are needed.

DIY - Do It Yourself Crafts: Join us in creating amazing crafts as seen on "Pinterest." Transform ordinary items into DIY clothing, jewelry, crafts, cosmetics, stationary and much, much more. No technical skill is necessary - just bring your creativity. Assembly required!!

Drawing & More!: This class will teach various drawing techniques using pencils, markers, pastels, and more! Each fun project will start with step-by-step instructions on a range of topics such as animals, people, places, outer space and more!

Duct Tape: We will be using the sticky stuff to make everything such as wallets, belts, flip-flops and more!

Flag Football: The game of flag football is an exciting non-contact sport. Students will learn the basic rules of flag football, as well as fundamental skills including passing and catching. Players will develop team building skills.

Guitar: Learn to play the guitar this summer! You will be taught how to read beginner notes as well as proper hand positions. *Guitars provided by CAPE for in-class use.*

Gymnastics: This course includes training on the low and high balance beams, vaulting and floor work for all levels.

2023 CLASS CATEGORIES

Hobby Shop: In this class you will sand, assemble, paint, and create your own toys and projects, while developing skills and unleashing creativity.

Jewelry Corner: Learn the latest trends in jewelry & fashion design. You and your friends can “show off” designer jewelry and wearable fashions created by you!

Karate: A self-defense class for everyone designed to teach the basics of Shaolin Kempo Karate. Children will learn how physical confidence, discipline, self-respect and effort pay off. UNIFORM NOT REQUIRED.

Keyboard: Learn to play the piano keyboard this summer! Beginner level instruction makes this class a great way to develop keyboarding techniques.

Mathletes - Brain Games: Enjoy fun-filled activities and games to foster an early awareness and a lifelong love of math. Students may not even know they are doing math as they participate in fun, confidence-building activities such as problem-solving, predicting and number games.

Minecraft Challenge: Students can choose between playing “Survival,” “Creative” or “CAPE Games.” Survival- Explore unknown lands, find natural resources, craft new and exciting items, and build a shelter to fend off the monsters of the night. Creative- Use your imagination to build whatever your heart desires - the sky's the limit! CAPE Games- Students can play their favorite staff created games: Spleef, Hot Foot, Capture the Flag, Gauntlet, Parkour Park, Duck Hunt, Sky Wars and test your skills in our class.

Modelmania: Unleash your creative energy with LEGOs, K'Nex kits and other building materials!! Students will also use 3-Dimensional puzzles, games and crafts to enhance their design, physics and math skills. Let your creativity shine!

Read Between the Lines: A reading class for all ability levels using exciting themes and stimulating activities to make reading fun and meaningful.

Ready to Read!: For new and beginning readers, have fun as you explore the world of reading through literacy skills, sharing, storytelling and games!

Robotics: Students will learn the basics of building and programming a robot to navigate tasks similar to regional Lego Competitions.

Science Adventures: This exciting, hands-on approach to science provides children the unique opportunity to conduct exciting and engaging experiments while learning to think and act like a real scientist. If your child loves science, this is the place to be!

Science Wonders: Is your child always asking why? This class will help them discover the fundamentals of science through hands-on experiments and activities geared to the very young student. Learning can be lots of fun.

Space - The Next Generation: Let's blast off through a worm hole to explore other planets and solar systems. You can build your own solar system, space station, moon buggy, spaceship or even a space pet!

Your child's safety remains our top priority. CAPE will adhere to all CDC, NYSDOH, Nassau County and local guidelines.

Title 45

Consistent with Title 45, the Creative Arts Program of East Meadow will provide, release, or publish information pertaining to students as may be appropriate under the circumstances. Parents or legal guardians who do not want the CAPE Program to release information must make a specific request in writing to the CAPE Director. Unless objection to any of the specific items in the following "Directory Information" is submitted in writing by parents, legal guardians, or those students over the age of 18 years, the Creative Arts Program of East Meadow herewith gives notice of intention to provide, release, or publish in the district newsletter or bulletins; the district website; school or student newspapers; magazines; yearbooks or other publications; daily or weekly newspapers; athletic programs; musical, theatrical, or award programs; news releases, videos, and school-related organizations, any or all of the following directory information pertaining to students as may be appropriate under the circumstances: the student's name, photograph, date of birth, parents' names, address, telephone number, date and place of recognized activities and sports, weight and height of members of athletic teams, dates of attendance, grade in school, immunization status, degrees and awards received, and the most recent previous educational agency or institution attended by the student. Under the regulations of this act, parents, guardians, or students over the age of 18 who do not desire the release of any of the above directory information must make a specific request in writing to the CAPE Director. Failure to make such a request shall be deemed as consent to release, provide, or publish the directory information during the remainder of the school year.
