

Do I have to have my own transportation?

Transportation is provided by each partner high school.

Students may also apply for a driving pass that will allow them to drive their own car to campus.

Apprenticeship, internship, and open enrollment students must provide their own daily transportation.






Will I get to see my schedule before school starts?

Students will receive information on how to access their schedules the week of August 6.


Schedules may also be picked up during our Career-Tech Kickoff event on August 14.

There are NO lab fees for attending Pickaway-Ross, but all students must pay \$50 a year for dues to their career-technical student organization.




Can I still participate in sports at my home school?

Yes! You will still be a student at your partner district high school when you attend.

We encourage you to participate in your extra-curricular activities like sports, clubs, band, etc.





Can I access grades and other information about my student?

Yes. Parents will be emailed information on how to access Progress Book and other student information systems.





Does Pickaway-Ross have a seperate calendar from my home school?

Yes. Students who attend Pickaway-Ross will follow the PRCTC calendar instead of their home school's.

Am I required to wear a uniform at Pickaway-Ross?

Yes. Since our students are preparing for the workforce, each program has its own program uniform. Program uniforms must be worn, except Fridays, and must not be covered up.

Each student receives four (4) program uniforms and has the option to order more uniforms, including sweatshirts, online.





When do I get my uniforms?

Students may pick up uniforms at our annual Career-Tech Kickoff event or they may pick them up on the first day of school.





Can I drive to school on the first day?

Yes. You will need to fill out your student driving forms and pay for your parking pass during the first week of school.
