The 2017-18 School Accountability Report Card (SARC) is available in the school office and on the district website at www.palermoschools.org. Under Proposition 98, California schools are required to prepare report cards annually and disseminate them to the public. The purpose of the SARC is to provide parents and community with information about the condition of school facilities and safety, staff and curriculum, school finances, and student academic performance.
