Dual Credit Courses

Earn college credit hours towards STC **core curriculum** courses (basics).

Career & Technical Education Programs

Earn a **Certificate** in high demand technical careers.



Designated High Schools

Earn college credit hours up to an **Associate degree**.

Academy Programs

Earn an **Associate degree** in the STEM,
Business, or Criminal
Justice field.

Dual Credit Courses









- Start as early as 11th grade
- Over 200 unique courses offered
- Students can earn college credit hours toward STC
 Core courses (42 credit hours) and
- Up to an Associate degree (60 credit hours)

Independent Courses - Requirements

- Be classified as a Junior or Senior in high school
- Course is not offered and/or available at high school as a dual credit course
- Cannot take any developmental or kinesiology courses
- GPA of a 2.0 or better
- Students must meet additional eligibility





Career & Technical Education











- Start as early as 9th grade (spring semester)
- Over 40 workforce programs
- High school endorsements align with Workforce programs
- Industry-Based Certificates (select programs)
- Students can earn college credit hours toward a Certificate or an Associate of Applied Science degree



- Start as early as 9th grade (spring semester)
- STC partners with
 - 33 Early College High Schools (4 in the planning stages),
 - 7 T-STEM Schools, and
 - 3 P-TECH Schools
- Students can earn college credit hours up to an Associate degree (60 credit hours)


