- The Texas School Survey is a collection of self-reported tobacco, alcohol, inhalant, and substance use data from among elementary and/or secondary students in individual districts throughout the state of Texas.
- The survey is conducted by the Public Policy Research Institute (PPRI) in conjunction with the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) and it is administered every other year to a representative sample of Texas students in grades 4 through 6 and grades 7 through 12.
- In the spring of 2012, the Texas School Survey was administered to a total 998 students in grades 4 through $6{ }^{\text {th }}$.
- A total of 1532 students in grades $7^{\text {th }}$ through $12^{\text {th }}$ completed the survey.
