

2018 Texas Academic Performance Report (TAPR) Annual Report and Public Hearing

March 27, 2019

The Texas Education Code (TEC), §39.306, requires each district's board of trustees to publish an annual report that includes the TAPR, district accreditation status, campus performance objectives, information on violent or criminal incidents, and information on the performance of the previous year's graduates in their first year of college, as reported by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board.

Each district's board of trustees must hold a public hearing to discuss the district's annual report within 90 days of receiving the TAPR on December 21, 2018 (winter break not included). Within two weeks following the public meeting, each district must widely publish its annual report, including posting it on the district website and other public places.

The Texas Education Agency awards an accreditation status to each public school district and charter school. The accreditation status is based on the academic accountability rating and financial ratings from the Financial Integrity Rating System of Texas. A district or charter must be accredited by the state to operate as a public school.








2018 STAAR Performance




2018 STAAR Percent at Meets Grade Level




2018 STAAR Percent at Masters Grade Level




2018 STAAR School Progress Domain- Academic Growth Score








Graduation Rates





RHSP/DAP Graduates Longitudinal Rate




College-Ready Graduates




College, Career and Military Ready Graduates




Completion of Either Nine or More Hours of Dual Credit in Any Subject or Three or More Hours of ELA or Math (Annual Graduates)




Associate's Degree (Annual Graduates)

La Joya Independent School District 2017-2018 Violent and Criminal Incidents Report By Dr. Armando Ocana School Safety Director

Violent and Criminal Incidents

- Texas statute (TEC 39.053) requires La Joya Independent School District to publish an annual report on violent and criminal incidents at the district.
- The report must include: number, rate and type of incidents, information concerning school violence prevention and intervention policies and procedures used by the district, and findings from the Safe and Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act (SDFSC) Survey.
