ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

Students may not be dropped off or picked up at the front entrance of the building.

Thank you for helping to keep your children safe during arrival and dismissal. Car riders arriving at normal drop off times (8:10 AM - 8:25 AM) should always use the AM procedure. The front entrance is designated for school buses only.

AM PROCEDURE - All traffic should enter from Coral Rd and follow the drive to the rear of the building. Students are to exit their car at the crosswalk and walk to door C2. Cars may exit to Sycamore Rd. or Coral Rd. When exiting to Coral Rd., please loop the student parking lot and watch for traffic going both ways. Monitors will be at the door at 8:10 AM. Door C2 will lock at 8:25 AM - Tardy Bell (Please take student/s to elementary office and sign them in).

PM PROCEDURE - All traffic should enter from Coral Rd and follow the drive to the rear of the building. Students will be dismissed at the crosswalk. Cars may exit to Sycamore Rd. or Coral Rd. When exiting to Coral Rd., please loop the student parking lot and watch for traffic going both ways.

Elementary car riders must obtain a car pass from the office in order to be picked up. Please pick up your pass in the office before the first day of school.



Did you know that Ohio offers a free program to assess and support child development from birth to age three?! Early Intervention (EI) is a program that will come to your home to evaluate your child to see if they may qualify for support. EI providers are well-trained professionals who use a non-judgmental and compassionate approach that empowers parents with skills, tools and confidence to nurture the healthy growth of their children. A student who receives services through Early Intervention is automatically connected with the Local School District to support the transition to preschool services at age three. Student Parking Permits

The cost is \$15 per parking pass. Students must have driver's license and current proof of insurance.



6TH GRADE ORIENTATION

Arrival & Dismissal Procedures

The buses drop off and pick up students in the front of the building, using the bus lane. Therefore, parents who bring their child(ren) to school must drop off and pick up students using the car lane. Please exit the parking lot on Coral Rd. For the safety of all children, it is requested to follow this procedure. Student drivers will park in the student parking lot behind the school. Students may exit either from Sycamore Rd. or Coral Rd.
