Application Guidelines

The Roland Zimmerman Inspiration Scholarship Fund has been established in honor and recognition of Agriculture Instructor, Mr. Roland Zimmerman. This scholarship is awarded to a student who has best demonstrated that their agriculture program will lead them to a career they love so like Mr. Z, that they will never have to work a day in their life. The recipient will demonstrate a mature sense of responsibility, high moral values and a devotion to family, agriculture, and their community.

At least one scholarship in the amount of \$1000.00 will be awarded annually.

The scholarship trustees will select up to three finalists for an interview. Each finalist will be notified of a date, place, and time for the interview.

The scholarship trustees are not affiliated with any of the high schools or Agricultural programs. No information except that contained on or relating to the application is used in the selection process. The scholarship trustees may verify information with the high school guidance counselors or agricultural instructors.

Any graduating senior living in Seneca County and actively participating in a high school agricultural program who meets the following criteria may apply for this scholarship.

1. Acceptance to a fully accredited two or four-year post high school agricultural program.
2. Participation in FFA activities as they pertain to the agricultural program in a local school
3. A letter of recommendation from your agricultural instructor.
4. A short statement of how the agricultural program led you to this decision.
