

 - Assesses fluency and comprehension
- Lexile (Gr. 5-8)
 - Computer-based
 - Identifies a students independent reading level using word complexity and sentence structure

Findings and Analysis

- Despite big concerns regarding a "slide" or "gap" due to the educational interruptions as a result of COVID-19, the students in Oceanport are faring well, and showed growth and progress during the 20-21 school year
- This data was used to guide the decision to include two intervention positions at Maple Place
- The continued use of data as a critical piece of instructional planning is a part of the district plan to optimize student achievement

What is ACCESS for ELLs?

- ACCESS: Assessing Comprehension and Communication in English State-to-State
- **WIDA**: World-Class Instructional Design & Assessment
 - Measures academic English language in four domains:
 - Listening, Speaking, Reading & Writing
- Administered to all K-8 students coded as English Language Learners (ELLs)
- Scores reflect proficiency from Level 1 (Entering) to Level 6 (Reaching)
- Educators use ACCESS results, along with other WIDA resources, to make decisions about students' English academic language and to facilitate their language development.

ACCESS 2020-2021 District-Wide Results

Students must achieve a composite proficiency level of 4.5 or higher in order to be considered for exiting the program. This score is considered among multiple measures for program exit.

DYNAMIC LEARNING MAPS REPORTING

- Alternate assessment for students with the most significant intellectual disabilities
 - Taken as an alternative to the NJSLA (Grades 3-8) by students who meet the eligibility criteria
 - Measures students' academic performance in English Language Arts, Mathematics and Science
- Enables students to better demonstrate what they know, understand and can do academically in relationship to the Essential Elements
- Every test is individualized

OCEANPORT 2020-2021 DLM OUTCOMES ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS/MATHEMATICS

100% of the students eligible to be administered DLM in English Language Arts and Mathematics participated in the assessment.

Supports, Interventions, & Programs

DLM Students with "Advanced Standings" will exit DLM testing, those "At Target Standings" will be reviewed during their Annual IEP Meeting to determine if alternative testing is still appropriate.

All DLM students will continue to receive an IEP academic program with individual goals and objectives according to their needs. (ICR, LLD, RR).

ELL Students are existed from ELL services when they obtain a 4.5 or higher on a the 1-6 WIDA scale. Score are obtained in August each year.

Current ELL Students receive services via ICR classrooms, and/or individual services daily.
