NEW CERTIFICATED EMPLOYEE INCENTIVES



Hueneme Elementary School District believes in order to attract and retain the highest quality certificated staff, we need to invest in our staff members. To attract potential staff, the District continuously maintains a salary schedule that ranks at the top within Ventura County and offers a very competitive health/welfare benefits package. The District covers the cost of the New Teacher Induction program for candidates who need to clear their credentials and matches each new teacher with an experienced, mentor teacher. In addition, the district offers regular professional development on all content areas and has built-in collaboration time at most of its schools.

DISTRICT STATISTICS

Hueneme Elementary School District's 8400 students attend eleven schools, including nine elementary and two junior high schools. Ten of our schools are designated as school-wide Title I schools and eight schools are Provision II schools where students receive a free breakfast and lunch. HESD's unduplicated student percentage is 89%. Our student demographics are: 82% Hispanic, 45% English Language Learners, and 87% Socio-economically Disadvantaged students. The District employs 430 Certificated and 300 classified staff members, each who is dedicated to ensuring every student receives an enriched, high-quality education.
