

MINUTES OF THE WIRT COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

The Wirt County Board of Education met in Special Session on Monday, May 2, 2016 at 5:00pm in the Wirt County High School Cafeteria for the purpose of a Student Discipline Hearing. Present were: Carl Brainard, president, Chuck Mills, Mark Lowe, Johnny Nemeth, members and MaryJane Pope Albin, secretary. Eddie Powell, absent.

Mr. Brainard called the meeting to order at 5:00pm, the pledge of allegiance was led by board member, Chuck Mills.

A student discipline hearing in regard to a recommendation of expulsion for 365 days for violation of 18A-5-1a, (b)(i) Possessing ..., controlled substance on premises of educational facilities, WV Code 60A, Uniform Controlled Substance Act, WVDE/WCS Safe and Supportive Schools Policy was held.

Mr. Brainard explained to the student and parent that these proceedings would be recorded. He asked the parent of student, Control Number for confidentiality 4182016, if she wished an open or closed hearing. Mother requested a closed hearing for her minor son. Mr. Brainard made a motion at 5:04pm to go into executive session for the purpose of conducting a student discipline hearing. Mr. Nemeth seconded the motion.

The board returned to regular session at 5:46 pm on a motion by Mr. Lowe. Mr Nemeth made a motion to expel student 4182016 for 365 days, second by Mr. Mills.

Ms. Pope-Albin explained Alternative Education program.

On a motion by Mr. Mills the meeting adjourned.
