The members of the Wirt County Board of Education met in their regular session on Tuesday, July 12, 2011 in the Wirt County High School cafeteria. Present were James Rader, President, Jerry Ash, Vice President, Carl Brainard, Mark Lowe, and Chuck Mills, members, and Daniel Metz, Superintendent.

Mr. Rader called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. On a motion by Mr. Lowe, seconded by Mr. Ash, the minutes of the previous meeting held on June 30, 2011, were approved.

On a motion by Mr. Ash, seconded by Mr. Mills, the Board approved payment of invoices totaling \$40,461.51.

On a motion by Mr. Mills, seconded by Mr. Ash, the Board approved the Superintendent's recommended transfer of Brittany Knicely to Wirt County Middle School, 5th and 6th grades.

By the same motion, John Workman was employed as Agricultural Education/Agriculture Mechanics Teacher at WCHS, 240-day contract, Janet Frazier, as Assistant Coach, WCMS Girls' Basketball, and Aaron Hill, Head Coach, WCMS Boys' Basketball.

On a motion by Mr. Lowe, seconded by Mr. Mills, the Board authorized an Interventionist teaching position at Wirt County Primary Center for the 2011-2012 school year.
