The Wirt County Board of Education met in a special organization meeting on Tuesday, July 5, 2022 in the Wirt County High School cafeteria. Present were Mark Lowe, Daniel Metz, Darren Shearlock, Brent Stewart, Randa Yoak, members, John McKown, Secretary.
