# MTHS - Athletic Hall of Fame Selection Details 

1. Names of athletes, coaches, teams, or other individuals may be submitted to any committee member at any time. Committee members shall forward these nominations to the Athletic Director. Committee members may also nominate candidates.
2. Once an athlete, coach, or other individuals has been nominated, all efforts will be made to obtain as much information as possible about the nominee so that the committee can make an informed decision. This will include mailing or emailing an information sheet to the nominee as well as obtaining information, when possible, from the nominator.
3. Once per year, the Hall of Fame Committee will vote on that year's nominees. It shall take a $2 / 3$ vote of the committee to confirm the nominee as a Hall of Fame member. The voting shall take place by the committee members in person. At least $75 \%$ of the committee shall be present in order to constitute a quorum.
4. If a committee member is being considered as a candidate for the Hall of Fame (as an individual), he or she shall not participate in the voting and must receive $2 / 3$ of the votes from the other committee members in order to be confirmed.
5. In any year, no more than five athletes, two coaches, two teams, and one other individual may be inducted into the Hall of Fame. In total, no more than six new Hall of Fame members may be inducted each year. It is not necessary that the award be given each year in a specific category.
6. The MTHS Hall of Fame Committee will present each inductee with an appropriate award. The inductee(s) will be recognized, if possible and practical, during the pre-game or halftime of a home football game.
7. The MTHS Hall Fame Committee will also place a permanent award in an appropriate place at the school honoring each inductee.
