MARSHALS:

First, congratulations for the hard work that has earned you this status.

Second, the position of marshal is not just an honor. It also carries certain duties.

Marshals are expected to be at all practices, awards night, and graduation in order to receive the medal. Baccalaureate service is requested unless there is a religious conflict. You should arrive at least 15 minutes earlier than the time we have listed for seniors to arrive. You are supposed to help guide the seniors during the practices and events, and you cannot do that if you are not present.

Marshals will follow the dress code established for the seniors for any practices.

For awards night, Baccalaureate, and graduation, male marshals will wear a black or navy suit, white dress shirt, a dark tie, and dark dress shoes. Male attire must meet the dress code requirements, or the status of marshal will be revoked.

Female marshals are required to wear white dresses or white skirts with white blouses. Dresses and skirts must meet the school dress code. All Junior Marshal attire must be pre-approved by Mrs. E. Barber prior to awards night.

We have had a problem in the past with female marshals wearing dresses that do not meet the code. Remember that strapless and open-backed dresses, dresses with shoulder bands less than 3 inches across, and low-cut attire are not permitted. Females should also wear skin-toned hose and white shoes. Female Marshals must wear white shoes with straps. No sandals or flip flops should be worn. Failure to wear appropriate attire will result in loss of marshal status. Choose shoes wisely: comfort over style. You will be standing for long periods of time, and you cannot take your shoes off.

Marshals will also wear the traditional marshal sashes.

If a marshal fails to perform his/her duty as described in this memo or as explained by the senior sponsors, he/she will lose the status of marshal. The honor of being a marshal will be removed from the student record.
