

Board Meeting. BURLINGTON-EDISON SCHOOL DISTRICT Nov. 9, 2015

The Board of Directors of the Burlington-Edison School District No. 100 met on Monday, November 9, 2015, in the Board Room of the District Office at 4:30 p.m.

In Attendance

Staff members present were Laurel Browning, Superintendent; Dr. Jeff Drayer, Assistant Superintendent; Joe Stewart, Special Education Director, Jeff Brown, Director of Finance and Technology; and Bryan Jones, Director of Equity & Assessment.

Call to Order

President Howard called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

Special Education Director, Jeff Brown, provided the Board with an update about the 1/10th of the 1% sales tax allocated for school-based mental health services. The county has hired University of Washington SMART Program Consultants to identify models in collaboration with the county, districts, and North Sound Mental Health Administration.

Jeff Brown, along with guest, Brenda Booth, provided information about the districts' Opportunity K Program. The Program will begin at the end of January 2016. Kindergarten teachers are developing a kindergarten guide that aligns with B-ESD's mission and vision. Brenda Booth articulated the themes from the guide and explained the importance of the developmental continuum. She highlighted the district concept map the district will be using. The document will be completed by the end of December.

Superintendent Laurel Browning, shared that the district will be applying for the state capital grant that was approved in the last legislative session.

Assistant Superintendent Dr. Jeff Drayer, brought New Board Policy 2027/District Ownership of Staff-Created Work to the Board for review and discussion.
