

Board Meeting. BURLINGTON-EDISON SCHOOL DISTRICT March. 11, 2019

The Board of Directors of the Burlington-Edison School District No. 100 met on Monday, March 11, 2019, in the Board Room of the District Office at 4:30 p.m.

Call to Order

President Wesen called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

1-5 Concept-Based Units of Study

Consultant Teachers, Tiffanee Brown and Grant Burwash presented a unit overview of K-5 Concept-Based Units of Study and how they implement and support teachers with this strategy. They discussed critical content, key skills, generalizations with guided questions, and trainings filled with information for teachers designed for learning. They also discussed their practice for establishing community partners like the police, fire department, Skagit Conservation District, Skagit Watershed and Mountain School for example. Resources are sourced through books, online and through these community partners.

WIAA Discussion

Athletic Director, Don Beazizo, discussed WIAA schedules pertaining to football. A factor to changing schedules is that there are declining numbers for enrollment in football in Washington. He explained league changes in 2020, Free and Reduced numbers will also play a role in how football schedules are formed.

Bond Results

Superintendent Browning discussed bond results. The bond failed at 53.02%. She compared the precincts approval and rejected numbers. Each precinct was divided up into percentages of below/or within the 50% or above the 60% mark. Next election and levy dates were also discussed.
