

IX. MISCELLANEOUS Continued

4. **Policy 3122/Excused and Unexcused Absences** has been updated to include the legal requirement requiring district staff to meet with a student found dependent pursuant to Chapter 13.34. RCW to discuss truancy.
5. **Policy 3421/Child Abuse, Neglect, and Exploitation Prevention**, is updated to expand its definitions to align with current law and to underscore that student on student abuse, neglect or exploitation can and does happen and does trigger the mandatory reporting statute.
6. **Policy 3422/Student Sports – Concussion, Head Injury and sudden Cardiac Arrest**, is updated to reflect new legal requirements regarding awareness and prevention of sudden cardiac arrest (SCA) and tracks the language and process of Zachary Lystedt law on concussion head injury.
7. **Policy 6114/Gifts or Donations**, is updated to include language in alignment with state nondiscrimination regulations. The updates also address teacher-solicited donations through crowdfunding organizations as well as providing clarity on gifts to staff.
8. **Policy 6512/Infection Control Program**, is updated to indicate that the Washington Department of Health recommends certain immunizations for school staff.
9. **Policy 6700/Nutrition and Physical Fitness**, is updated to clarify federal guidelines for the National School Lunch Program and Competitive Foods. Notably, the new language includes the requirement to protect the identity of students eligible for free and reduced-price meals in accordance with the USDA guidelines.
10. **New Policy 2030/Service Animals in Schools**, is being adopted to acknowledge the District's legal requirement to permit students and/or adults with disabilities to be accommodated by a "service animal" as required by federal and state law.
