Hello MMS Students and Families,

#### Attendance

An area of continuing concern for many is student attendance. Please remember that our policy states students are not to exceed 52 hours of parental absences for the entire year. Once that benchmark has been hit, only a professional documented note will be considered for an excused absence. You will be contacted and receive a letter if your child hits any of the following benchmarks according to HB 410:

#### **Excessive Absences: (includes absences with doctor notes)**

- Absent 38 or more hours in one school month with or without legitimate excuse;
- Absent 65 or more hours in one school year with or without legitimate excuse

#### **Habitual Truant:**

- Absent 30 or more consecutive hours without a legitimate excuse;
- Absent 42 or more hours in one month without legitimate excuse;
- Absent 72 or more hours in one year without a legitimate excuse;

If your child's attendance does not improve, charges may be filed with Champaign County Juvenile court.

Please remember to contact the middle school office any day your child is not attending. If we are not contacted for 2 consecutive school days, the attendance officer will be sent to your residence.

### **Progress Book**

As we start the new quarter please continue to utilize *ProgressBook* to keep informed on your student's grades and attendance (both daily and each class period). If you need help in setting up this account, please email Emily Ridgway at <a href="mailto:ridgwaye@mcburg.org">ridgwaye@mcburg.org</a> and she will be glad to help. When you look at your student's grades you may see one of the icons next to specific assignment listed below. I have included their meaning to clear up a few questions raised at parent teacher conferences.

- **Excluded** = your student has been *excluded* from this particual assignment
- Missing = your student is missing this particular assignmet
- **Late** = this particular assignment was turned in *late*
- weighted = this particular assignment is weighted (has more or less value) than other assignments
