

Hello MMS Students and Families,

I hope this letter finds you well and you enjoyed Thanksgiving with family and friends. This letter is just to reiterate some information and notify you of some important upcoming dates/events.

## School Fees

Student fees should be $25 \%$ paid at this time. Students must have $25 \%$ paid to be eligible to attend the dance Friday night. Fees will need to be $50 \%$ paid by January 3 , and $100 \%$ by end of third quarter, March 15 th.

## Washington D.C. payments and paperwork

Please be certain you have completed your intent to attend and made payments asap in order to be eligible to go.

## Attendance

An area of continuing concern for many is student attendance. Please remember that our policy states students are not to exceed 52 hours of parental absences for the entire year. Once that benchmark has been hit, only a professional documented note will be considered for an excused absence. You will be contacted and receive a letter if your child hits any of the following benchmarks according to HB 410:

## Excessive Absences: (includes absences with doctor notes)

- Absent 38 or more hours in one school month with or without legitimate excuse;
- Absent 65 or more hours in one school year with or without legitimate excuse


## Habitual Truant:

- Absent 30 or more consecutive hours without a legitimate excuse;
- Absent 42 or more hours in one month without legitimate excuse;
- Absent 72 or more hours in one year without a legitimate excuse;

If your child's attendance does not improve, charges may be filed with Champaign County Juvenile court.
Please remember to contact the middle school office any day your child is not attending. If we are not contacted for 2 consecutive school days, the attendance officer will be sent to your residence.

## Progress Book

As we start the new quarter please continue to utilize ProgressBook to keep informed on your student's grades and attendance (both daily and each class period).
