Objective 2.1

Decrease by 10% the number of students not meeting state standards.

Strategies

- Develop a curriculum that is aligned with the Illinois Common Core State Standards (CCSS).
- Create grade level curriculum maps, unit plans, lesson plans, performance activities, and assessments.
- Assure that all teachers are highly qualified and provide training to assist teachers with effective curriculum implementation.
- Provide a mentoring program for staff.
- Provide weekly grade level/content area meetings.
- Provide interventions that utilize best teaching practices.
- Utilize differentiated instructional practices in every classroom.
- Implement RTI practices.
- Utilize PBIS principles throughout the school.

Objective 3.1

Strategies

Objective 4.2

Provide a healthy environment with strategies for a healthy lifestyle.

Strategies

- Provide open gym time in a structured setting for scheduled groups of students, integrating reading and math with kinesthetic activities.
- Provide speakers for large group topics like nutrition, cleanliness, clothing care, etc.
- Encourage teachers to get involved in educating the "whole" child in their area of individual needs (i.e., reading intervention, family support systems).

Objective 4.3

Every student in every classroom will be safe.

Strategies

- Playground equipment will be serviced and maintained regularly.
- District surveys will be used to enhance safety issues.
- Walkie-talkies will be readily available to be used at the discretion of the
- teachers.
- Updated safety inservices will be provided for staff.
- All classrooms should have a locked area (closet or filing cabinet).
