Community Kearny is an established suburban residential community (population of 41,422) with a mixed cultural

background, situated in the northwest corner of Hudson County where it meets Bergen and Essex

Counties. Kearny is located 12 miles west of NYC.

School Kearny High School, home of the Kearny Kardinals, is a four-year comprehensive public high school

with an enrollment of 1717 students. The school is accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools and the New Jersey Department of Education. The average academic

class size is 15.

Faculty There are 150 full-time faculty members; more than 52 percent have graduate degrees. In addition to the

Director of School Counseling, there are nine counselors and one Student Assistance Counselor. The

counselee-counselor ratio is 205:1.

Schedule Kearny High School operates on a full-year schedule with semester options.

Curriculum Courses are offered in both college preparatory and non-college preparatory subjects including CTE

programs. Enrollment in Advanced Placement and Honors courses is by faculty recommendation and student interest. Kearny High School offers 17 AP courses and 18 Honors courses. Offerings in Art, Music, Dance, Industrial Arts & Technology are open to all students. The district utilizes Google for Education. Each student is assigned a chrome book to access Google Classroom. Students are offered the

opportunity to earn college credits through Advanced Placement courses and on-site and off-site

partnerships with Hudson County Community College, William Paterson University, Rutgers University

and The Culinary Institute of America.
