B. <u>RENEWAL OF STUDENT ATHLETIC INSURANCE</u>

The Kearny Board of Education, based upon the recommendation of the Business Administrator/Board Secretary, hereby authorizes the renewal of Student Athletic Accident Insurance for the 2020/2021 school year with Bollinger, Inc./Zurich Insurance Co. at the annual premium amount of \$128,802.00. Due to the COVID-19 shutdown in the 2019 policy term, Zurich is including a credit on the 2020/2021 policy of \$17,997.00. This will result in an invoiced renewal of \$110,805.00 for the 2020/2021 policy.

C. RENEWAL OF PROPERTY, LIABILITY & WORKERS COMPENSATION INSURANCE

Resolved: That for the record, it be noted, that the quotation submitted by the Board's Insurance Agent of Record, COOK MARAN & ASSOCIATES on behalf of the assessment levied by the School Alliance Insurance Fund (SAIF), be hereby approved in the amount of \$1,194,036.00. This represents a 3% increase for the 2020/2021 school year. Per SAIF's Safety Incentive Program, the district is eligible to receive a safety credit of \$8,000 and a 100 point bonus credit of \$1,000. Assuming that the parameters of the Safety Incentive Program are met by the district, the above referenced credits could bring the overall assessment for the 2020/2021 school year down to \$1,185,036.00.

D. APPROVAL OF SPECIAL EDUCATION TUITION CONTRACT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES OFFICE OF EDUCATION

The Kearny Board of Education, based upon the recommendation of the Business Administrator/Board Secretary and Director of Special Services, hereby approves the 2019-2020 Special Education Tuition Contract with the Department of Children and Families Office of Education for one (1) student (M.D.) beginning September 5, 2019 through June 30, 2020 for 180 days at a per diem rate of \$81.77, an annual tuition amount of \$14,718.60.
