


No Final Exams

- Due to the removal of Final Examinations, classroom grades over the entire semester: 100%
- Last Days of the Semester
 - Meaningful Learning
 - O Common Classroom Expectations
- Student's are excused the final SIP day of each semester if they meet <u>ALL</u> student incentive guidelines for the 2022-23 school year. (See below)
 - O Last SIP Days
 - December 16th
 - May 5th (seniors) & May 19th
 - O Incentive Guidelines
 - 70% or higher Grade in all classes
 - No more than two tardies to a class (or 7 total)
 - No skips to the class or skipped evening detentions
 - No suspensions (ISI or OSS)

FAFSA Completion Nights



PCHS will be hosting FAFSA completion events

Thursday, October 6th from 6:00 PM - 7:30 PM &

Wednesday, November 9th from 6:00 PM - 7:30 PM

in the PCHS Cafeteria.

Several financial aid specialists will be on campus to assist parents/guardians as you complete the FAFSA online.

All seniors, regardless of income, should complete the FAFSA each year.

The FAFSA will be completed using your 2021 tax documents.

Become familiar with Federal Student Aid by visiting https://fafsa.ed.gov/.

Please bring your Chromebook.

You and your student will **EACH** need to create an **FSA ID**. This can be completed at https://fsaid.ed.gov/npas/index.htm. Your student SHOULD NOT use **your** email address **or** his/her Pekin High email address to create his/her ID as he/she will not have access to it after graduation. Each **FSA ID** must use a **unique** email address. Make sure to write this information down in a safe place.

AP Exam Registration Open Aug 17th-Sept 30th!!

Any student enrolled in an AP course has had the AP exam fee(s) added to their skyward account. The total cost **per exam** is \$88 unless on free/reduced for lunch. Fees need to be **paid at the BFO or in Skyward in-full no later than Sept. 30th.**

Any students **NOT** wanting to take their AP Exam(s) needs to inform Mrs. Bisping or Mrs. Slover in the Counseling Office by the Sept. 30th deadline.

Any **fees not paid** by Sept. 30th will result in an exam **NOT** being ordered for the student.

Student ID'S

Students are to carry their student ID's at all times and be prepared to present their ID anytime they are in the building or at a school activity. If a student checks in late they will be required to present their ID. If they have lost their ID a new one can be purchased at the BFO for \$4.00.
