2023 Summer Driver's Education I

WHO: Students must be at least 15 years old, have at least 5.5 credits, and have passed at least 8 courses the previous two semesters.

WHERE: A105

WHEN: Monday -Thursday, May 30-July 10, from 7:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.

- No Class on Fridays
- No Class on June 19, July 3 or July 4
- Students may not miss more than 2 classes

FEE: \$100 - paid at the Dragon Store window next to the principal's office


HOW TO SIGN UP: Pick up the form in the counseling office. Once you've signed and completed the form, return to your counselor.

2023 PCHS SUMMER DRIVER'S EDUCATION II

(Behind The Wheel)

WHO: Students must have passed Driver's Education I (classroom portion.) AND have a valid driver's permit.

• All students will be assigned by the group they picked and age. Priority will be given to students by the group they picked and who is the oldest in that group.

WHEN: Classes are Monday through Thursday (see form for full schedule)

- Students may not miss more than one class.
- Do not sign up for a session if you are going to be on vacation or have a job which will interfere with your driving time.

FEE: \$100 (there is no extra charge for summer DEII) paid in the Dragon Store

HOW TO SIGN UP: You can pick up the form from Mrs. Patton in the Athletic Department (D201). Once you signed and completed the form turn into Mrs. Patton in the Athletic Department (D201) by the pillar entrance.

to return the form and pay the DEII fee
