

## Response to Intervention Notification for Parents/Guardians

### Introduction

The Muhlenberg County School System is committed to providing the highest quality education for every student. We recognize that all students learn at different rates and may require different levels of support to attain success. In order to meet the needs of all students, a multi-tiered system of support is implemented, known as Response to Intervention (RtI).

#### What is RtI?

RtI is a multi-tiered system of support. There are three tiers in RtI:

Tier 1	Instruction provided to ALL students in a whole group, classroom setting (regular
	classroom instruction)
Tier 2	Additional instruction provided in a small group setting to target specific skills
Tier 3	Intensive instruction provided in an individual or small group setting

The RtI system is used to help all students. Students that are performing below grade level expectations academically or behaviorally will receive tier 2 or tier 3 instruction. Student academic or behavioral data, as well as teacher recommendations, are used to identify students in need of tier 2 or tier 3 interventions.

RtI can be used at any grade level (preschool, elementary, middle or high school) and for any content area (reading, math, writing, science, social studies). It is most often used in reading, math, or behavior.

## How is RtI implemented?

Once a student has been identified as performing below grade level expectations in a particular area and placed in Tier 2, a team of trained school personnel will develop an intervention plan. This intervention plan will include an individualized learning goal, an instructional plan, and regular assessment of student progress. Interventions are provided in small groups or individually. Students will receive interventions in addition to regular classroom instruction.

For example, a student having difficulty in reading may be provided additional instruction in Tier 2 in a small group of three to five students for 30 minutes three days a week. The student's progress is measured weekly to see if the additional instruction is helping the student achieve his/her learning goal. Depending on progress, 1) the student can exit Tier 2 interventions 2) the plan can be revised throughout Tier 2 or 3) the student may be considered for more intensive interventions and be moved to Tier 3.
