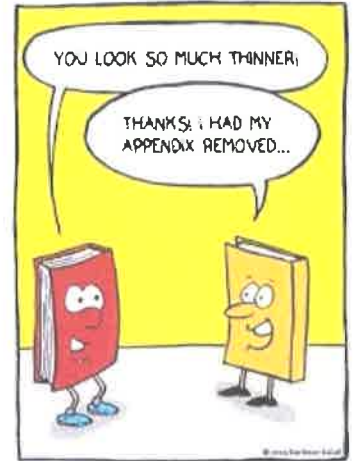


Looking for Book Donations
