

Call to Order

The Board of School Trustees of the Southwest School Corporation met in Special Session on Monday, October 21, 2019, at 9:01 a.m. in the School Corporation Board Room, 1502 N. Section St., Sullivan, Indiana. All Board Members were present except Jon Bobbitt. Others present included Superintendent Chris Stitzle and Assistant Superintendent Jon Stuckey.

Tentative Collective Bargaining Agreement

Superintendent Stitzle read the following:

The 2019 Indiana General Assembly enacted legislation (SEA 390), codified at Indiana Code 20-29-6-19(a), requiring a school employer to conduct a Public Meeting to discuss a tentative collective bargaining agreement at least seventy-two (72) hours before it is ratified by the school employer. This statute further requires that the school employer post notice of the time and location of the Public Meeting and the tentative collective bargained agreement on the school employer's Internet web site at least seventy-two (72) hours prior to the Public Meeting.

Therefore, the Board of School Trustees posted the tentative collective bargaining agreement document on the school's website as required by law, and is holding this Public Meeting in accordance with SEA 390. The tentative agreement contains the salary, wages, and wage-related fringe benefits negotiated by the parties for Corporation teachers for the 2019-2021 school years. This document will continue to be available for review by the public, and the public will be permitted to provide comment on the document at the Board's Ratification Meeting scheduled for Thursday, October 24, 2019 at 6:00 PM.

Mr. Stitzle passed out the tentative Agreement and discussed with the Board. President Wilson asked for any discussion? Board Member Mitzie Badger clarified that the contract was for the 2019-2021 school years. There was no further discussion.

Upon call for further business and there being none, the meeting was adjourned at 9:05 am.
