REGULAR USD 251 BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING

March 20, 2019 at 7:00 p.m.

1. CALL TO ORDER:

The regular meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Matt Horton in the BOE meeting room in Americus. BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT:

2. PRESIDENT'S REMARKS:

Matt Horton reminded everyone of the upcoming Savannah Chestnut concert at NHHS this Friday. It'll be \$5 for adults, kids are free. There will be a potato bar fundraiser as well. He gave kudos to the senior class for their leadership. Further he mentioned an email from Reta Jackson, asking if they could use the Reading school building for a class reunion.

3. SUPERINTENDENT'S REMARKS:

a. HEAR GEMINI REDESIGN UPDATE:

Summer work will include secured entrances, new lockers etc. Bids will be sent out and gathered by HTK, then brought to the board for approval. Tim Burton (Wendy Linsey) moved to approve a contract with HTK for planned summer remodel projects at NLC and NHHS. Motion passed. (7-0)

Tammie Reed thanked Mrs. VanGundy for all her years of service and dedication. She further said that the safety of our children shall be the main goal.
