Immunization Requirements for 2022-2023 School Year

All 50 States and the District of Columbia have immunization requirements for children entering school. In Nebraska, children cannot attend classes until the school has written proof of their immunization status.

Each school in Nebraska is required to keep on file the immunization history of the students enrolled. Parents/Guardians must present one of three documents to the school to verify immunization status:

- *An immunization record showing that the child is protected by age-appropriate immunization.
- *A signed statement by a physician that the required immunization would be injurious to the student or family members.
- *An affidavit signed by a legally authorized representative stating that the immunization conflicts with the practices of a recognized religious denomination of which the student is a member.

A student may be provisionally enrolled in a school in Nebraska if he or she has begun the immunization series and continues the necessary immunizations as rapidly as is medically feasible. If the student does not continue with the immunization schedule, he or she will be sent home.

Nebraska Immunization requirements for all students in grades *Kindergarten through 12th Grade*, including all transfer students outside the State of Nebraska and any foreign students:

- 3 doses of DTaP, DTP, DT or Td vaccine, one given on or after the 4th birthday.
- 3 doses of polio vaccine
- 3 doses of pediatric Hepatitis B vaccine or 2 doses of adolescent vaccine if student is 11-15 years of age
- 2 doses of MMR or MMRV vaccine, given on or after 12 months of age and separated by at least one month
- 2 doses of varicella (chickenpox) or MMRV given on or after 12 months of age. Written documentation (including year) of varicella disease from parent, guardian, or health care provider will be accepted. If the child has had varicella disease, they do not need any varicella shots.

Additionally, for 7th Grade only:

1 dose of Tdap (must contain pertussis booster)

Please call the school office or visit with your physician if you have any questions or concerns about what your child needs to be in compliance with the Nebraska immunization requirements.
