Anticipated Opening: Life Skills Teacher

We are looking for a **Life Skills Teacher** to help develop and implement a K-5 Life Skills Program for students with developmental needs. The Life Skills Teacher will have an opportunity to build and run a program for a small group of students while receiving support from administration, special education and mainstream teachers, ed techs, and specialists.

The ideal candidate for this position will understand special education procedural requirements, collaborate and communicate effectively with St. George school staff and outside providers and agencies, build a strong team to support the Life Skills program, and implement specific teaching and supporting strategies to meet students' individual needs.
