1st - 12th Grade Student Registration FAQs

- 1. Q: I requested an account online. Now what?
 - A: Check your email for your login information and instructions.
- 2. Q: How do I request a specific elementary building?
 - **A:** After submitting your online registration, email <u>ibull@geneseoschools.org</u> to request the required form. (If there is an older elementary sibling already attending Geneseo, the student will be automatically placed at the same school as the sibling. You do not need to fill out a form in this situation.)
- 3. **Q:** I already have children that attend Geneseo School District. Do I still have to provide Proof of Residency for my new student?
 - **A:** Yes. Proof of Residency is required for ALL new students even if there are siblings already enrolled in the district.
- 4. Q: I'm having issues logging in to my Skyward account. Who can I contact?
 - A: Email Nitzy Bull at ibull@geneseoschools.org or call 309-714-3240.
- 5. **Q:** Do I pay registration fees now?
 - A: Registration fees must be paid between July 10th and the first day of school.
- Q: What if I would like to request an application for Free or Reduced rate for lunch and registration fees?
 A: The application for the 2023-2024 school year will be available in July. It will be posted here on the District Website.
- 7. Q: When will Registration close?
 - A: Online registration will close on Monday, August 14th at 4:00 p.m.
- 8. **Q:** Will there be an in-person registration this year?
 - **A:** No, there will not be an in-person registration this year. If you need assistance with registration or access to a computer, please contact Nitzy Bull at ibull@geneseoschools.org or 309-714-3240.
- 9. Q: My child was enrolled in the Geneseo School District previously but not last year. How do I register?
 A: You will login to your Skyward Family Access account but change the Login Area to NEW STUDENT REGISTRATION underneath where you enter in your login ID and password. You will then register the child as a new student. All new student documentation, including proof of residency, will be required.
