In April, we will begin administering the state mandated standardized tests known as the Colorado Measures of Academic Success (CMAS), which assesses students' knowledge of state academic standards in science, English, language arts, social studies, and math. As a district, we value the state testing results as additional data on our progress as a school and would encourage you to let your student(s) take the test to ensure that our school is rated accurately. The test results do impact our school rating and accountability with the state. As a parent, you do have the right to opt your student out of the state testing. If you do wish to opt your student out of the state assessment, you will need to make the request in writing to the school principal.
