Roseau Schools recognizes that with the implementation of the Customized Student Learning initiative there is a need to protect the investment by both the District and the family. The 1:1 Device (MacBook Air/iPad) insurance cost is noted in the table below and will be due upon receipt of your student's 1:1 Device.

This annual coverage begins upon receipt of the payment and ends at the conclusion of each school year. The 1:1 Device insurance cost will provide insurance coverage for accidental damage as outlined in the Technology Device Acceptable Use Policy. Lost or stolen devices and/or accessories are not covered under the insurance program.

Students of families who opt out of the insurance option will not be able to take the device home and will be required to check their 1:1 Device out each morning and return at the end of each school day. Grades K-5 must leave devices in their school classroom all year.

INTENTIONAL DAMAGE: Students/parents are responsible for full payment of intentional damages to 1:1 Devices. School District 1:1 Device Protection DOES NOT cover intentional damage of the 1:1 Device.
