District Budget Planning

The District budget development process has begun as administration is analyzing the educational impact of the Governor's Proposed State Budget. The recommendations from Wisconsin's Blue Ribbon Commission on School Funding will likely play into the state budget process as well.

There are ongoing conversations regarding education funding at the state legislative level that will likely result in changes prior to the final state budget. It is expected that the entire process may take several more months to arrive at an approved state budget. Unity will be working through budget calculations and implications through the spring.

Student Open Enrollment Is Open for 2019-2020

What is Public School Open Enrollment?

Wisconsin's inter-district public school open enrollment program allows parents to apply for their children to attend a school district other than the one in which they live. Applications may be submitted to up to three nonresident school districts.

Who may participate in open enrollment?

Pupils in 5-year-old kindergarten to grade 12 may apply to participate in open enrollment.

Open enrollment for prekindergarten, four-year-old kindergarten and early childhood education is limited. Parents should call their resident school districts to find out if their preschool-aged children qualify for open enrollment.

How and when may parents apply?

The open enrollment application period for the 2019-20 school year is from February 4-April 30, 2019. The application period closes at 4:00 p.m. on April 30, 2019. Late applications will not be accepted for any reason. Parents may apply online at https://dpi.wi.gov/oe.
