### **STEPS TO FOLLOW FOR TREATMENT AND CONTROL OF HEAD LICE**

Check off each step as completed:

- \_\_\_\_ 1. Obtain a lice-killing treatment product and use **AS DIRECTED** for infested individuals only.
- \_\_\_\_ 2. Remove all nits (eggs) from the hair shafts with nit comb or fingernails  
Re-infestation may occur if even one live nit remains on the hair shaft.  
**Head lice will spread until they are treated with a chemical that kills lice and until the eggs have been killed or removed.**
- \_\_\_\_ 3. Soak hair care tools in hot water (130°F) for at least 10 minutes. Heat may damage some plastic combs and brushes. Place these items in a sealed bag for two weeks.
- \_\_\_\_ 4. Wash all personal clothing (including underwear, pajamas, coats, hats scarves, etc.) and sheets in hot water (130°F) during the washing process. Dry laundry using high heat for 20 minutes. Pillows, mattress, mattress pad, and blankets also need to be treated. (Items that can't be washed and dried may be sealed in an air-tight plastic bag for 14 days.) Floors, carpet, upholstered furniture, drapes, cars, pillows and mattresses should be vacuumed to pick up any hairs that may have living lice or nits attached to them. Remember to destroy vacuum cleaner bag.
- \_\_\_\_ 5. Dry clean clothing that cannot be washed or put clothing in a sealed plastic bag for 14 days.
- \_\_\_\_ 6. After treatment, it is **necessary** to continue to check for live louse and remove nits daily until no more live louse or nits are detected.

**\*\* Remember, be proactive and check your child's hair often to prevent the exchange of live louse and nits. Educate your child about sharing hair accessories, clothes, uniforms, costumes, coats, etc. Please be honest and have open communication with the school and other parents regarding exposure to live louse and nits.**
