	Bonnie Becker Memorial Scholarship	The student must be active in the community and document their volunteer time to any nonprofit organization such as a church, youth group, hospital, school or other organization. The student must display exceptional character, manners, respect and integrity which are more important than academic accomplishments. The student must be able to get along easily with others and have good social skills. Leadership qualities are desired. Areas of education which relate to serving people are desirable such as medical, teaching, ministry, etc., but these are not required	\$300
	Charles J. Schreiner Memorial Scholarship	Must be attending a four-year college or technical college in an agricultural related field (if no Ag. field applicants, then a general business student will be selected). Must be earning a GPA of "C" and have financial need.	\$250
	Dr. William E. Wright Memorial Scholarship	Student must be a graduate of MHS and have high scholastic performance. Student must be enrolled in a professional or vocational health-care curriculum; or enrolled in a collegiate, pre-professional health-care curriculum with an aptitude for and sincere interest in following through with professional training. Student must have a sincere interest in family or rural health care and a career in Mondovi or Buffalo County.	\$500
	Duane and Dolly Rutschow Scholarship	Must be majoring in nursing and maintained a 3.0 GPA in grades 11&12. Financial need may be considered. If no candidates for nursing, other medical careers can be considered.	\$200
	Earl Bruegger Memorial Scholarship	Student must be a MHS graduate with a B average, have financial need, & have completed at least two high school business courses.	\$100
	Ed and Shirley Mahlum "Good Citizen" Scholarship	Student must be attending a college or technical college. Student must have a "B" average.	\$300
	Edward M. Adams Memorial Scholarship	Student must be majoring in Accounting or a related career.	2 at \$100

Must have a grade point average of a B, must have participated in activities working with children such as: teaching assistant in elementary, 4-H, MCRYC after school projects, helping with church activities, etc. Must write an essay on "What makes you feel you would be a good teacher?"	\$100

	American Legion Auxiliary Scholarship	Parent must be a Veteran and a member of the American Legion or American Legion Auxiliary. A grandchild or great grandchild may apply if she is an American Legion Auxiliary member. Student must be in the top 1/3 of their class, have a sincere desire to further his/her education, and be working to earn a portion of her/his tuition. <i>(Additional form on scholarship homepage required)</i>	\$200
	Buffalo River Masonic Lodge 252 Scholarship	Scholarships open to all career choices but must show proof of acceptance at a university or technical college (ACCEPTANCE LETTER). Student must show leadership and service in school, community, and church and show financial need. <i>(Additional form on scholarship homepage required)</i>	\$1000
	Continuing Education and Community Service Scholarship	Must attend a four-year college or university. Student must be in top 20% of graduating class, and have participated in some kind of community service your Senior year. <i>(Additional form on scholarship homepage required)</i>	\$200
	Jane Ede Memorial Scholarship	Student must be majoring in teaching, list work experience with children, and write why he/she is going into teaching. <i>(Additional form on scholarship homepage required)</i>	\$200
	Jason Christenson Memorial Scholarship	Must be accepted to a college or technical college; (include college acceptance letter) have a B average; a minimum 2 years in athletic extracurricular activities, and submit an essay on "Friendship". (The essay should be at least 1-1.5 typed pages)	2 @ \$1500
	Kurt and KC Catt Memorial Scholarship	Student must be attending a four-year college or technical college. Must be earning a high school grade point average of a "C". Student must write an essay on "What have you done to go above and beyond to help somebody, and how did it make you feel?" <i>(Additional form on scholarship homepage required)</i>	\$500

	Merlin Mikelson Memorial Scholarship	Student must be attending a college or university going into education and have a "B" average. Student must submit a short essay/explanation why education/teaching was chosen as their field of study.	\$500
	Mondovi Athletic Association Scholarship	Student must attend a college or technical school. Must have a minimum grade point average of a "C" and volunteer in youth programs. Must have participated in high school sports. <i>(Additional form on scholarship homepage required)</i>	2 @ \$500
	Nick Nelson "Stout Hearted" Scholarship	Student must be attending UW-Stout and majoring in a STEM related field. Special consideration will be given to those students majoring in Computer Science. Students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 as well. Finally, applicants must submit an essay on why they have chosen UW-Stout and their field of study.	\$500
	Stub (Gaylord) Schultz Memorial Scholarship	Student must write and submit a paragraph on individual interest in community service and plans on how he/she will help the community; or on the applicant's career plans with a paragraph indicating financial need and entering a program in marketing, sales, business, or politics. Student must have a grade "C" average or better and be enrolled in a post-secondary school.	\$400
