Services are delivered in local communities through collaborative partnerships with Federal, State, and local resources.

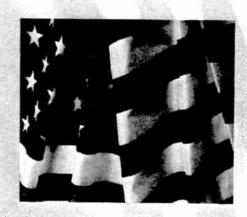
