Job Summary:	Working with staff and students to assess students' individual needs, meet with guardians and create Individualized Education Plans, monitor their progress over goals and objectives as stated in a student's IEP.

Performance Responsibilities:

General

- Assessing children's individual needs.
- Provides an educational program for students as defined in the students Individualized Education Program (I.E.P.).
- Works cooperatively with regular classroom teachers, interpreting the abilities and disabilities of these students, co-planning and assisting in classroom intervention strategies, modifying general education curricular as necessary.
- Collaborating with various parties to design individualized programs.
- Employing suitable classroom management techniques.
- Keeping records of lesson plans, and records of children's performance.
- Communicates regularly with parents and professional staff regarding the educational, social, and personal needs of students.
- Completes necessary reports and record keeping as required by state and local policies and procedures.
- Participates in professional growth activities through staff development, in-service, workshops, and higher education.
